

Your Nantucket home away from home

CHECK IN: is at 3:00pm, please be mindful that in most cases previous tenants have recently vacated the property and the window of time for cleaners to prepare between guests can be a challenge. Please do not arrive early unless previous arrangements have been approved.

CHECK OUT: Please check out on time. The cleaners are scheduled to come in around 9AM on the day of your departure to inspect and clean the house for incoming guests. Please leave the house unlocked for the cleaners.



it was found. Nantucket housekeepers are typically paid between \$30-\$40/per hour/per person. One of the most time consuming aspects of the turn-over cleaning is washing the towels and sheets and remaking the beds.

- Please strip the beds and start the laundry.
- Dispose of open food items in the refrigerator.
- Sort recycling and trash to bring outside to designated bins.
- Wash or place dirty dishes in dishwasher and start the cycle.
- Please replenish paper goods and cleaning supplies as needed.

The more you can do to help clean the house prior to leaving, the more likely it is to reduce the cost of the cleaning service. If you have left the house clean, the linens washed, the beds made, please leave a note for the cleaning service letting them know what you've done, so efforts are not duplicated. Of course, everyone's standards are different and the cleaning service is ultimately responsible for leaving the house clean and ready for the next tenant and they will have to do whatever is necessary to accomplish this.

RECYCLE: The Nantucket Landfill goes to extraordinary efforts to recycle and handle waste disposal. As of January 2000 all household trash must be placed in clear garbage bags. Please sort recycling (glass and cans separate from paper) and place in clear plastic bags as well. The clear bags should be provided for you at the rental home. Trash removal companies will not accept trash that has not been sorted, you will be charged an additional fee if recycling and trash is not properly separated and accessible for pick up on designated days.

BBQ GRILLS: If you used a propane gas grill during your stay, please be sure to close the nozzle on the propane tank after every use. If you empty one, you may either choose to call the caretaker of the property or exchange it at Stop & Shop for a full tank.

THE SANITIZED KEY was left for you at arrival. Please return it to JPFCOs downtown office at, 19 Centre street prior to leaving the island. Mail slot for evening drop off.

IMPORTANT CONTACT NUMBERS: Your agent has left a personalized note with important phone numbers, including caretakers and cleaners; If you come across a house–related issue please contact the caretaker, your agent or call the office at 508–228–3202.



Explore Nantucket

BEACHES

Experience the "secret" beaches Nantucket has to offer. Many visitors only know the popular beaches, South Shore Beaches, such as Cisco or the north end beaches like Jetties Beach. But maybe it is time to experience a few news ones.

Children's Beach:

15 Harborview Way, in town. A waterfront community park with a large grassy picnic space with benches, playground equipment, sandy beach, restrooms, sheltered area and 'The Hungry Minnow' snack bar.

Jetties Beach:

4 Bathing Beach Road. One mile from town; popular, family friendly beach on Nantucket Sound with warmer, calm waters. There are lifeguards, showers, public restrooms and a playground. After the beach, stop by Sandbar Beach Bar & Restaurant, for food and fun that is kid friendly!

Nobadeer Beach:

Near the airport. Party scene beach with a younger crowd, lifeguards and commonly heavy surf.

Cisco Beach:

Near the end of Hummock Pond Road on the southern side of the island. Popular surfing beach with commonly heavy surf.

Stop by Cisco Brewery on your way home for Nantucket made beer and live music!

Siasconset Beach:

Located at the eastern most tip of the island about 7 miles from town. Surf can be heavy with strong currents; there is a lifeguard and food available in nearby 'Sconset Village. 'Sconset Beach can be reached either from Milestone road and bike path or slightly longer Polpis road and bike path. Stop by The Summer House, Beachside Bistro for lunch!

Dionis Beach:

Located on the northern shore, about 3 miles from town.

Warmer, calmer waters for swimming with lifeguards; this beach is suitable for children.

Miacomet Beach:

Miacomet Road. Quieter beach on the south side of the island with a beautiful pond nearby.

Steps Beach:

Steps Beach Path off Lincoln Circle. Beautiful Beach in the Cliff Rd. area with many steps down to get to the beach. Beautiful scenery for photo opps and gorgeous sunsets!

Surfside Beach:

End of Surfside Road on Nantucket's south shore, about 3 miles from town. Accessible by a bike path or shuttle service from town. Popular family beach with lifeguards, restrooms, parking and the Surfside Beach ShACK, snack bar.

Tom Nevers Beach:

5 Miles from town, this beach is slightly more remote. The surf can be heavy and beach access is sometimes difficult. An old Navy Base stands nearby. During summer 2017 this beach was great for whale watching!

Madaket Beach:

End of Washington Ave. Beautiful beach on the west side of the island with lifeguards and beautiful sunsets! Stop by Mil-lie's for a drink or a bite afterwards!

*Nantucket is 14 miles long by 3.5 miles wide, relatively flat with few hills. Choose to explore independently or join an organized bike tour. There are 35 miles of bike paths, giving you the opportunity to appreciate the island's natural beauties close up. Enjoy the ride!

LIGHTHOUSES



Nantucket has 3 working lighthouses, each with their own distinctive look and history.

Brant Point Light

Established in 1746 and was the second light established in Colonial America. Located on Easton St.

Great Point Light

Officially, Nantucket Light, first built in 1784 and located on a thin split of beach where the Atlantic Ocean and Nantucket Sound meet at the Coskata-Coatue Wildlife Refuge.

Sankaty Head Light
