# Your Nantucket home away from home

### **CHECK IN: 3:00PM**

Please be mindful that in most cases, previous tenants have recently vacated the property. The window of time for the cleaning company to prepare between parties is utilized in full, so please do not arrive early unless arrangements have been approved in advance.

### **CHECK OUT: 9:00AM**

Please check out of your rental property on time. The cleaning company is scheduled to arrive as early as 9:00AM on the day of your departure to inspect and clean the house for incoming guests. Please leave the house unlocked for the cleaning crew when you leave.



**PROPERTY CONDITION:** It is important to make sure that the property is left in the same condition as it was found. Nantucket cleaning companies typically charge between \$35–\$45 per hour, per person, therefore it is in everyone's best interest to help expedite the cleaning process. A few ways you can help reduce the cost of cleaning are:

- Strip the bed linens and start the laundry process
- Dispose of open food items in the refrigerator
- · Sort recycling and trash into their designated bins outside
- · Wash or place dirty dishes in the dishwasher and start the cycle
- · Replenish paper goods and cleaning supplies as needed

The more you can do to assist in the cleaning process of your rental property, the more likely you are to reduce the cost of the cleaning service. If you have left the house cleaned, linens washed, and beds made, please leave a note for the cleaning service so efforts are not duplicated. The cleaning service is ultimately responsible for using their discretion and prior experience to leave the property cleaned and prepared for the next tenants.

**RECYCLE:** The Nantucket Landfill goes to extraordinary lengths to recycle and handle waste disposal. The most recent cell developed at the Landfill is set to last the island community at least a decade – let's make sure to help the effort! The recycling program, established in 1996, and the clear garbage bags mandate, established in 2000, are both mandatory. Clear garbage bags should be provided for your use at the rental property. Rubbish removal companies will not accept trash that has not been sorted and will charge an additional fee if it is unsorted and/or not accessible on the designated pick up days.

**BBQ GRILLS:** If you'll be using a propane gas grill during your stay, please be sure to close the nozzle on the propane tank after every use. If you empty a tank, you may either call the caretaker of the property or exchange it at Stop n' Shop for a full tank.

**PROPERTY KEYS:** Keys to your rental property were left for you at arrival. At the end of your stay, please return all keys to the J Pepper Frazier Company downtown office at 19 Centre Street. Please use the mail slot if you return the keys after business hours.

**IMPORTANT CONTACTS:** Your agent has left a personalized note with important phone numbers, including caretakers and cleaning companies. If you come across a house–relat–ed issue, please contact the caretaker, your JPFCO agent, or the office at (508) 228–3202.

## Explore Nantucket

### **BEACHES**

Experience the 82 miles of soft, sandy beaches Nantucket has to offer! Many visitors only know the popular stops like Surfside Beach on the South Shore and Jetties Beach on the North Shore. If you haven't ventured out of your ocean-side comfort zone, try one of our recommendations below!

### Children's Beach:

15 Harborview Way, in town. A waterfront community park with a large grassy picnic space with benches, playground equipment, sandy beach, restrooms and sheltered area.

### **Jetties Beach:**

4 Bathing Beach Road. One mile from town; popular, family friendly beach on Nantucket Sound with warmer, calm waters. There are lifeguards, showers, public restrooms and a playground. After the beach, stop by Sandbar Beach Bar & Restaurant, for food and fun that is kid friendly!

### **Nobadeer Beach:**

Near the airport. Party scene beach with a younger crowd, lifeguards and commonly heavy surf.

### Cisco Beach:

Near the end of Hummock Pond Road on the southern side of the island. Popular surfing beach with commonly heavy surf. Stop by Cisco Brewery on your way home for Nantucket made beer and live music!

### Siasconset Beach:

Located at the eastern most tip of the island about 7 miles from town. Surf can be heavy with strong currents; there is a lifeguard and food available in nearby 'Sconset Village. 'Sconset Beach can be reached either from Milestone road and bike path or slightly longer Polpis road and bike path. Stop by The Summer House, Beachside Bistro for lunch!

### Dionis Beach:

Located on the northern shore, about 3 miles from town.

Warmer, calmer waters for swimming with lifeguards; this beach is suitable for children.


### Miacomet Beach:

Miacomet Road. Quieter beach on the south side of the island with a beautiful pond nearby.

### Steps Beach:

Steps Beach Path off Lincoln Circle. Beautiful Beach in the Cliff Rd. area with many steps down to get to the beach. Beautiful scenery for photo opps and gorgeous sunsets!

### Surfside Beach:

End of Surfside Road on Nantucket's south shore, about 3 miles from town. Accessible by a bike path or shuttle service from town. Popular family beach with lifeguards, restrooms, parking and the Surfside Beach ShACK, snack bar. 774–333–3833 • SurfsideBeachShack.com

### **Tom Nevers Beach:**

5 Miles from town, this beach is slightly more remote. The surf can be heavy and beach access is sometimes difficult. An old Navy Base stands nearby. During summer 2017 this beach was great for whale watching!

### Madaket Beach:

End of Washington Avenue beautiful beach on the west side of the island with lifeguards and beautiful sunsets! Stop by Millie's for a drink or a bite afterwards!

Cisco • 4 miles to Cisco Beach

**Cliff Road** • 1.2 miles from Crooked Lane at Cliff Road towards Madaket (this path joins Madaket bike path or Eel Point path after 1.2 miles)

**Eel Point / Dionis Beach** • 1.4 miles from Cliff Road path to Dionis Beach

Madaket • 5.5 miles to Madaket Beach

Milestone / Siasconset • 6.8 miles to from the rotary to 'Sconset Beach

**Polpis** • 9.5 miles from the rotary to 'Sconset Beach

**Surfside** • 2.2 miles from the high school (Starts at Atlantic Avenue & Vesper Lane) to Surfside Beach

\*Nantucket is 14 miles long by 3.5 miles wide, relatively flat with few hills. Choose to explore independently or join an organized bike tour. There are 35 miles of bike paths, giving you the opportunity to appreciate the island's natural beauty close up. Enjoy the ride!

### **LIGHTHOUSES**



Nantucket has 3 working lighthouses, each with their own distinct look and history.

### **Brant Point Light**

Established in 1764, this was the second lighthouse erected in Colonial America. Located on Easton Street, Brant Point Light both welcomes and bids adieu to visitors and locals alike traveling on the ferries. Toss a penny over your shoulder when you round Brant Point headed to Hyannis and you are sure to return.

### **Great Point Light**

Officially called Nantucket Light, Great Point was first built in 1784. Located on a thin split of beach where the Atlantic Ocean and Nantucket Sound meet at the Coskata–Coatue Wildlife Refuge, the current Great Point is actually the third structure in the light's history.

### Sankaty Head Light

Built in 1850 and located at the easternmost point of the island, Sankaty Lighthouse is a true Sconset gem. Moved from it's original location in 2007, Sankaty stands watch over the acclaimed Sankaty Golf Course and the bluffs of the eastern shore.
